Great Barton Parish Council objects to the planning application DC/23/0630/FUL on the grounds that; It is contrary to GB1 Spatial Strategy of the Great Barton Neighbourhood Plan; the site is outside of the settlement boundary (designated as in the countryside). It is also contrary to DM5 Development in the Countryside as the proposed replacement dwelling does not respect the scale and floor area of the existing dwelling it is 136% larger. The site will therefore be overdeveloped. The location is considered a viewpoint across the land and as such this does not conform to West Suffolk Council policy DM5 development in the countryside or DM27 housing in the countryside.
